# Bachelor of Engineering Technology (BEngTech) in Fire Engineering Level 7

Dublin Institute of Technology, Bolton Street in conjunction with the Institution of Fire Engineers is planning to offer a Bachelor of Engineering Technology (BEngTech), Level 7 Ordinary Degree, in fire engineering on a modular, part time basis (four yearly stages) in the next collegiate year.

A level 6 higher certificate exit award is available to students who successfully complete the first three stages of the programme.

The entry requirements are as follows:

- ❖ A minimum of 5 subjects in the Leaving Certificate or equivalent to include at least two ordinary level C3's or equivalent, a pass in English or Irish and an Ordinary level D3 grade in Mathematics; or
- ❖ Successful completion of the IFE Preliminary Exams; or
- ❖ Mature students with relevant work experience.

The IFE Level 3 Diploma (*old Graduate Exam*) will allow for advanced entry into the second stage of the programme. Recognized prior learning, (RPL), will be taken into consideration for module exemptions on an individual basis.
